Fair Trade provides the means for small farmers to live sustainably: by using environmentally-friendly production methods, guaranteeing them a fair price in order to support their families, and using the premiums to improve the community's standard of living.

## What Fair Trade products does Good Foods carry?

## Is Equal Exchange synonymous with Fair Trade?

## What is the difference between Fair Trade and "free trade"?

"Free trade" is an economic system where goods and services between or within countries can be traded without government-imposed restrictions such as taxes, tariffs, legislation, and quotas. Fair Trade focuses on how producers and workers are treated and compensated for their goods.
