1. Sampling Attendance

We encourage local vendors to join us at the Co-op in order to meet shoppers, talk about what they have to offer, and allow people to sample their products. Someone from your organization should set-up in-store in order to let people know who you are, what you're about, and why they should give to your group. Any day is open for tabling, but, in order to maximize the impact and give people the most time to give, we recommend earlier in the month.

2. Participation in a check presentation

We want to get your name out there as much as possible, so we want to host a "Give Where You Live happy hour" from 5:00 to 7:00 in our cafe. Our hope is that we can invite shoppers, and even non-shoppers, to join us in getting excited about your organization. Someone from your group is expected to attend this happy hour the month of your partnership in order to promote your organization and the month after your partnership to participate in a check presentation.

3. Social media and/or email mentions

We like to promote your cause on our social media accounts and in our eblast, so it would make the most fundraising sense if you did the same at least twice throughout your partner month. Don't forget to tag us!
